

WHAT TO KNOW BEFORE A TATTOO SESSION

PREVIOUS RECOMMENDATIONS

- Eat before going to get a tattoo, in order to avoid fatigue or possible fainting.
- Do not smoke before tattooing, neither tobacco nor marijuana.
- Do not consume alcohol 24 hours before starting the session and 48 hours after. Alcohol makes the tattoo bleed more, it also does not allow a good healing and the colors are not as strong.
- It is not convenient to continue a tattoo session from one day to the next, remember that the skin is irritated, injured and the next day it hurts more. It is best to wait for it to heal well.
- The skin must be totally healthy and without wounds.

WE INFORM

- We do not tattoo under 18 years old!
- We do not tattoo people who cannot present a valid identity document!
- We do not tattoo people who do not sign the "Informed Consent for Tattoos" document!
- We do not tattoo people who are under the influence of alcohol or drugs!
- That if any retouching of your tattoo is necessary, we will take care of it as long as you have attended the prescribed revisions. Likewise, we indicate that the touch-ups, if any, must be done a month, a month and a half maximum, from the day of their completion; After this period, no retouching will be carried out due to the contrasts in the intensity of the inks and in any case, they will be treated as a new job and must be paid as such.
- That healing is 50% of the work and is your responsibility, when getting a tattoo. You must come to reviews, for control. Non-attendance means that we cannot guarantee the good condition of these and their follow-up.
- To book an appointment, it is necessary to leave a deposit that will be subtracted from the total cost of the tattoo. The remainder will be paid on the day of the tattoo and before the session begins (to avoid misunderstandings). If you cannot attend the appointment, please notify us at least 48 hours before, otherwise the signal will be lost.
- That the tattoo needles are disposed off in a container for biological material, located in the "sterilization room" of the premises and periodically removed by an accredited company for the collection of such material.
- That the material used in the practice of tattooing is properly packaged. Reusable tubes are ultrasonically cleaned, packaged and sterilized in our autoclave, in the on-site sterilization room. The single-use material is shown to the client before it is opened and, once used, it is disposed of in the presence of the client.
